תהליך "כרייתם "של רעיונות חדשים מאפיין את מקבץ עבודות הסטודנטים מהתואר הראשון והשני בעיצוב תעשייתי.

"דיזיין בוננזה" מבטא את הרוח האקספרימנטלית של בצלאל, המעודדת את הסטודנטים להטיל ספק ולחפש אחר החדש בצורה, בחומר וברעיון, ככלים לבחינה מתמדת של תחום העיצוב.

החלומות המוצפנים ב"דיזיין התערוכה מציגה את כלי החפירה של המעצב, כתהליך של חיפוש דרך בין צמתים: שוליים ומרכז, ישן וחדש. בוננזה" מוצג ים כשלוש מהויות: עפר, אבק וזהב. הראשונה מבטאת את זמן החיפוש, השנייה את רגע הפיצוץ והמציאה והשלישית את תהליך הזיכוך של הגילוי, והפיכתו לרעיון טהור ומעודן.





The term "Bonanza" expresses an alchemic moment: a dream in which a new idea is born, the discovery of a treasure.

The "mining" process of new ideas characterizes the chosen batch of works by industrial design students at the Bezalel Academy of Arts and Design, Jerusalem, one of the most recognized design academies in the world.

"Design Bonanza" expresses the experimental spirit of Bezalel, which encourages the students to doubt and look for that which is new in the material, shape and idea, as tools for continued examination of the field of design.

The exhibition presents the designer's digging tools as a process of searching for a path between junctions:

margins and center, old and new.

The hidden dreams in "Design Bonanza" are presented here using three essences: dirt, dust and gold. The first represents the period of the search, the second the moment of explosion and discovery, and the third, the transformation into a pure and refined idea.

'needle and thread' shoes by hadas ilani

for the second year, the belzalel academy of arts and design, jerusalem presents the work of forty-five of their undergraduate and graduate students, in an exhibition on show at ventura lambrate during milan design week 2012, this year's theme is 'design bonanza', which is set to 'express the experimental spirit of the academy as well as the creative research, which encourages the students to doubt and look for that which is new in the material, shape and idea, as tools for continued examination of the field of design," says haim parnas, head of the bachelor design program.

one of the works on show is 'needle and thread' a series of shoes constructed from pine needles by hadas ilani. contemplating local material, hadas' experiment consisted of finding different sewing techniques to keep the separate pine needle strands together, creating a textile which is then formed into shoes, the unique material choice is ecological due to its popularity in the region, the consideration of using pine needles as a raw material alluding to the gentle needle mat and the previous lives of the needles







We've seen many a tea set in our day--so many in fact that our eyes tend to gloss over when we come across them. But this one, from Rachel Boxnboim http://rachelboxnboim.com/, is different: It appears to be made



That's no surprise, since the Alice tea set began as a sewing project:
Boxnboim, a recent Bezalel http://www.bezalel.ac.il/en/grad, had the idea to sew a teapot out of panels of fabric. She made a cloth replica of her mother's old teapot and used it as a ceramic mold. Once in the kiln, the fabric burned away, leaving its texture on the final pieces. "I made a connection between a soft material (fabric) and a hard material (ceramic), perpetuating and preserving the properties of the fabric." Boxnboim writes. The ceramic takes on... the appearance of the seams and looks like a kind.





Bezalel's Design Bonanza at Milan Design Week 2012



technology, which revives the ancient use of salt as a preservative.

For the second year running, Bezalel Academy of Arts and Design will display its innovative, unique and creative designs at the Ventura Lambrate Collective Space during the Milan Salone Internazionale del Mobile this April.

Bezalel has chosen the theme, "Design Bonanza", for this year's exhibition. According to Prof. Ezri Tarazi, head of the Master of Design (M.Des) programme, and Haim Parnas, head of the Bachelor of Design programme and also the show's curators, "Design Bonanza" expresses the experimental spirit of Bezalel as well as the creative research, which encourages the students to doubt and look for that which is new in the material, shape and idea, as tools for continued examination of the field of design.

Bezalel's students have moulded their designs based on solving problems, producing experimental designs that have practical uses. Some are life-saving objects, like the "Ruins Catheter", the "RedBeard Helmets" and the "Earthquake Proof Desk", while others are produced according to pre-historic ideas using modern technology, such as the "Glass Knives for the Post-Modern Neanderthal".

Some items use natural materials such as the "Needle and Thread" shoes made out of pine needles and "Preserved", a project that focuses on pressing

Idan Raizberg's life-saving "Ruins Catheter" is a modular system designated to rescue a person trapped under a collapsed structure. The system gets its inspiration from a medical balloon catheter used to expand arteries. It is designed as a capsule, which is put into the opening of the ruins and is opened by inflating an air bag and locked at the size that enables a person to crawl through. After opening the first segment, it is possible to send through it additional units, and by doing so, to create a safe corridor for rescuing people during a disaster.

Shai Lanir's "RedBeard" helmet is a project that was created in the shadow of the "helmets law" in Israel, which hovered over the fashionable heads of the city's cyclists. It was unclear whether the law would be enforced and all cyclists would be forced to be seen in public as if an aerodynamic spaceship had landed on their heads. Sketches, photographs, wandering, tests, knitting, spilling, smearing, and sewing created three helmets made of hardened wool in epoxy material, with a removable interior sewn from Cordura and cotton, and lined with polyethylene foam combined with polypropylene.

"The balance in the design world is shifting from beauty-only products to designs that are more practical and problem-solving in nature," said Parnas. "The shift is towards experimental design that pushes us forward into producing products that have real, practical uses.

Of the 2,500 exhibitors, a limited number of design academies were chosen to present advanced technology projects, and Bezalel, as one of the chosen academies, will be presenting designs that incorporate new technologies to solve various problems, as well as old technologies revamped for the modern era, the school said.

The "Gold Rush" from the early 20th Certury is replaced at the beginning of the 21st Century with a new "Gold Rush", which emanates from the beginning of the decline of the modern financial and social system. However, the real "gold" is in the free imagination, the aspirations, and the exposed, albeit filled with emotion, perspective of new creators. The bidden dreams in "Design Bonanza" try to illustrate the urge, discovery and future products of young designers in Israel.
