## Yuko Hasegawa



Curator Yuko Hasegawa will deliver a lecture entitled "Japanese Contemporary Art from The MOT Collection in the context of Pop Art" at the Tel Aviv Museum of Art on Tuesday, 21 January at 8 p.m. Curator Nirith Nelson will moderate the evening and hold a talk with Hasegawa following the lecture.

Ms. Hasegawa is Chief Curator of the Museum of Contemporary Art, Tokyo (MOT), Founding Artistic Director of the 21st Century Museum of Contemporary Art, Kanazawa and Professor at the Department of Art Science, Tama Art University, Tokyo.

The lecture will examine the ways in which Japanese artists - including Kohei Nawa, Yayoi Kusama, Yoshitomo Nara, Takashi Murakami, Ryoji Ikeda and Michihiro Shimabuku express their identity amid pop culture and globalization, from the post-war period, the 1980s and new Japanese art of today. The lecture is structured around four main themes: Altering Reality and Perception; The Influence of Pop Art; Technology in Modern Life; and One's Place in the World.
