

re:scale / Open Call for Student Design/Build Competition

This Fall, the School will present an exhibition called **re:scale**, which will explore the concept of scale through the construction of a miniature golf course. We invite you to submit your designs, and the winner will build the course, designed for use, at full scale.

Miniature golf is popular around the world, and especially in America. This will be one of very few courses in Israel and must be either 9- or 18-holes. The site will be the School's courtyard/garden, and the space between the buildings may be used (though this is not required). The course can be constructed in any way so long as it is fully functional.

Your design must be submitted by August 31st, 5pm in digital format to: adva@bezalel.ac.il. We encourage, but do not insist on collaboration between students of different years. Designs should be presented in PDF format, 10 slides, no more than 10MB.

The winner will be announced on 5 September. The course must be completely built by 24 October and the selected team will be in charge of construction management until project delivery. A cash award for the winning team of 3,000 shekels will be paid upon completion. You will be supported by competition coordinator Arch. Adva Matar throughout the process. A construction budget of 15,000 shekels will be supplied. Attached the AutoCAD files of the compound for your convenience.
